AAA Prayer Meeting

Begin your prayer meeting by reading together Psalms 40:16-17 (also found in Ps. 70:4,5). Keep your Bible open before you, as these verses will provide a pattern for your time of prayer.

Part 1 - Adoration

- "Let all those that seek Thee rejoice and be glad in Thee..."
 (v. 16)
- Focus on the character of God
- Allow each person to praise God for a specific characteristic or attribute of God that is personally meaningful.

Part 2 - Appreciation

- "...let such as love Thy salvation say continually, The Lord be magnified." (v. 16)
- Focus on the blessings of salvation
- Allow each person to give a brief testimony of their own personal salvation experience.
- Allow each person to then thank the Lord for a specific blessing in personal salvation.

Part 3 - Acknowledgement

- "But I am poor and needy, yet the Lord thinketh upon me..."
 (v. 17)
- Focus on personal need
- Allow each person to express their own need of God in prayer.
- After each person prays, have one other person pray for them as well.
