An Encounter With God

1. A Specific Place

- A place of aloneness "Jacob was left alone" (Gen. 32:24)
- A place of <u>stillness</u> "enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul...for, behold he prayeth." (Acts 9:11)
- A place of <u>quietness</u> "Samuel was laid down to sleep" (I Sam. 3:3)

2. A Special Time

- A time of <u>disillusionment</u> "(Gideon) if the Lord be with us, why then is all this befallen us?" (Judg. 6:13)
- A time of <u>discouragement</u> "(Moses) *I am not able to bear all this people alone, because it is too heavy for me.*" (Num. 11:14)
- A time of <u>despair</u> "(Elijah) he requested for himself that he might die" (I Kings 19:4)

3. A Sensitive Heart

- A personal awareness of <u>helplessness</u> "(Peter) Lord, save me" (Matt. 14:30)
- A personal acknowledgement of <u>need</u> "(David) Oh Lord, hear me, for I am poor and needy." (Ps. 86:1)
- A personal attitude of <u>brokenness</u> "(Job) the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away" (Job 1:21)

4. A Serious Crisis

- <u>Failures</u> of the past "(Manasseh) when he was in affliction, he besought the Lord his God." (II Chron. 33:12)
- Frustrations in the present "(Jehoshaphat) We have no might...neither know we what to do" (II Chron. 20:12)
- Fears for the future "(Abraham) What wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless?" (Gen. 15:2)

5. A Sincere Prayer

- A prayer of <u>desperation</u> "(Hannah) out of the abundance of my complaint and grief have I spoken" (I Sam. 1:16)
- A prayer of <u>dependence</u> "(Asa) help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee" (II Chron. 14:11)
- A prayer of <u>dedication</u> "(Mary) be it unto me according to thy word" (Luke 1:38)
