

Prayer and Share

Rom. 1:16 – *“The gospel of Christ...the power of God unto salvation”*

I Cor. 15:1,2 – *“The gospel...by which also ye are saved”*

1. **Comprehension** of the truth - pray for **eyes** to be opened

- *“to **open their eyes**...to turn them from darkness to light”*
(Acts 26:18)
- **Man is lost in the darkness of sin, unable to find his own way to God.**
- *“...the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not...”* (II cor. 4:4)
- *“...having the understanding darkened...because of the blindness of their heart.”* (Eph. 4:18)
- Request: _____

2. **Connection** to the truth - pray for **doors** to be opened

- *“...for a **great door and effectual is opened** unto me...”*
(I Cor. 16:9)
- **We must find a way to connect with the individual which will build trust, respect, and appreciation.**
- *“God...opened the door (Antioch) of faith unto the Gentiles”* (Acts 14:27)
- *“...a door (Troas) was opened to me of the Lord”*
(II Cor. 2:12)
- *“...praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ”* (Col. 4:3)

3. Communication of the truth - pray for mouths to be opened

- *“Praying always...that I may **open my mouth** boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel...that I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.”* (Eph. 6:18-20)
- **The message of the gospel must be clearly spoken and it must be clearly heard.**
- *“...and grant unto Thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak Thy Word.”* (Acts 4:29)
- *“Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.”* (Acts 8:35)

4. Conversion by the truth - pray for hearts to be opened

- *“A certain woman named Lydia...whose **heart the Lord opened...**”* (Acts 16:14)
- **Lives are changed when a right choice is made to respond to the message of the gospel.**
- *“God...hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”* (II Cor. 4:6)
