

Praying Scripturally

Biblical Prayer Lists

Allow the Word of God to become your prayer guide as you pray for specific and special needs. With an open Bible, **read through**, **study through**, **think through**, and then **pray through** the Scriptures as you consider the needs that you are praying about.

- ❖ A personal prayer list – Personal character lists in the New Testament:
 1. Beatitudes – **Matt. 5:1-12**
 2. Love chapter – **I Cor. 13**
 3. Fruit of the Spirit – **Gal. 5:22, 23**
- ❖ A husband praying for his wife – **Prov. 31:10-31**
- ❖ A wife praying for her husband – The 7 “*Blessed is the Man*” passages in the book of Psalms (**1:1-2; 32:2; 34:8; 65:4; 84:5; 94:12; 112:1**)
- ❖ Parents praying for their children – **Luke 2:40, 52**
(mental, physical, spiritual, social needs)
- ❖ Children praying for their parents – **Prov. 24:3,4 (2:6)**
- ❖ Members praying for their church – **Eph. 4:11-16**
- ❖ Citizens praying for their leaders – **Prov. 8:12-21**
- ❖ Brothers and sisters in Christ praying for each other – **Col. 1:9-12**
- ❖ Praying for the salvation of lost people – Various “*open*” passages in the New Testament:
 1. **Col. 4:3** – Open doors
 2. **Eph. 6:19** – Open mouths
 3. **Acts 26:18** – Open eyes
 4. **Luke 24:45** – Open minds
 5. **Acts 16:14** – Open hearts
