

Revival Synonyms - “Revive us again” (Ps. 85:6)

The word “revive” is made up of two parts, the first of which is a prefix. The prefix “**re-**” comes from a Latin term which means “again” or “again and again”. When placed in front of the root word “**-vive**” which means “live or life”, we create a word that speaks of living again, bringing back, or returning to a life once known or experienced. The Bible has some wonderful words which use the same prefix to express unique dimensions of revival:

❖ “rejoice” (Ps. 51:8); “renew” (Ps. 51:10); “restore” (Ps. 51:12)

Revival must be seen, not as an event or experience, but rather an ongoing reality in the lives of the people of God. Personal salvation can occur in a single moment, but personal revival must go on and on. Begin to make a list of other words that further explain the realities of revival. Select words that not only have a similar word structure, but also convey a similar truth about revival.
