Worship Worksheet

"For Thou art great, and doest wondrous things, Thou art God alone."

Ps. 86:10

Begin your time of worship by reading the account of worship in II Chronicles 7:1-4. In your Bible, highlight the following key words: "bowed" (v. 3), "praised" (v. 3), "worshipped" (v. 3), and "offered" (v. 4). These 4 words portray the attitude, the atmosphere, the attraction, and the action of worship. Worship involved their bodies, mouths, minds, and hands. Make note that the people were consumed with and overwhelmed by the presence of their God. As their prayer went up (ch. 6), the fire came down (7:1), and the glory moved in (7:1,2). God was alive and well in the midst of His people, and they knew it.

Key Elements in Worship (you will need your Bible and a songbook)

- 1. **Adoration** focus on the person of God
 - "Thou art God alone" (who God is)
 - Choose a song to sing that emphasizes who God is (an example might be "Praise to the Lord the Almighty")
 - The **song** you chose: _____
- 2. Praise focus on the attributes of God
 - "Thou art great" (what God is like)
 - From Psalm 86 (a Psalm filled with God) select a verse that gives several things that you are thankful for about God, and praise Him for them. (Psalm 145 also works well)

- 3. Thanksgiving focus on the works of God
 - "(Thou) ...doest wondrous things" (what God has done)
 - Make a list of 5 ways that God has been good to you.
